Organ transplantation is a life-long commitment. An important part of preparing for a transplant is making sure you understand your insurance coverage and financial responsibility for ongoing care and medication.

The Heart Transplant Clinic, the Pulmonary and Lung Transplant Center, the Stem Cell Transplant Clinic, as well as the Liver, Pancreas and Kidney Clinics provide comprehensive multidisciplinary medical and psychosocial care.

Antirejection medications are critical in maintaining the transplanted organ. During the first year after transplant, the cash price for anti-rejection drugs can cost \$1,500 to 1,800 per month. After the first year, the costs are reduced significantly.
