NORD, the National Organization for Rare Disorders, offers RareCare® Patient Assistance Programs that provide several free prescription drugs to uninsured individuals who cannot afford to buy them.

Each case is reviewed individually, and for complicated cases, a Review Committee makes the decision and the amount. Most patients who apply are uninsured, have insurance without prescription drug coverage or are waiting for pre-existing condition clauses to expire.

The Early Access Program allows a limited number of individuals to receive investigational drugs before FDA marketing approval.
