NARIC is a library and information Center focusing on disability and rehabilitation information. NARIC also maintains the National Institute on Disability and Rehabilitation Research (NIDRR) program directory, as well as maintaining a collection of documents produced by NIDRR funded projects.

Offers free information and referral services for anyone, professional or layperson, who is interested in disability and rehabilitation. NARIC also offers a document delivery service. Document delivery fees are five cents per page with a \$5.00 USD minimum. International shipping charges do apply. Customized database searches and 50 abstracts are available for \$5.00 UDS. Publishes an annual directory of federally funded projects. Services are free and available by phone, mail, fax, email, and online. Website offers 5 searchable databases, calendar of events, and timely information. Maintains REHABDATA, a bibliographic resource of disability and rehabilitation research.
