- To preserve the heritage of the watermen of the Chesapeake Bay
- To interpret their culture and their contribution to the region
- To provide and support educational opportunities
- To preserve and enhance the environment of the Chesapeake Bay

The Museum offers living history interpretation and activities, presentations of historical artifacts, and hands-on exploration of the environment. Adult education programs include lectures, videos and demonstrations scheduled periodically by the museum. The Museum also has a wooden boat-building program.
