Blue Ridge Care Connection for Children (BRCCC) is a program sponsored by the Virginia Department of Health which is an advocate for Children with Special Health Care needs. The BRCCC can also offer financial assistance and support with some pre-approved medical bills, equipment and medications.

The BRCCC is a collaboration between the Virginia Department of Health and the University of Virginia Children's Hospital. The BRCCC is directly affiliated with the UVA Children's Hospital.
