Our Special Needs Trust enhances the individual with a disability's quality of life by allowing the individual and/or their loved ones to save money without jeopardizing benefits. The funds invested in the trust will be used to provide security, support, extra comforts and services, medical care and other supplemental needs not covered by benefits or insurance.

Programs like Medicaid and Social Security have a maximum asset limit of \$2,000. If your loved one with a disability may ever have more than that amount, you should consider establishing a Special Needs Trust.
