- Day or Evening Groups: This less intensive treatment helps women identify the symptoms of substance use disorder and develop skills to overcome addiction and lead healthier lives.
- Co-occurring Disorder Group: This small group integrates the recovery process with mental wellness. Topics include medication compliance, relationships, family issues, stress management, self-care and trauma.
- Anger Management: This 10 week small group combines substance use prevention with education about how to manage anger and aggression.
