Starting in late September 2024, every American household will be eligible to order tests through [COVIDtests.gov](https://covidtests.gov/). Right now, the U.S. government is making COVID-19 tests available to uninsured individuals and underserved communities through existing outreach programs. Please contact a [HRSA-funded health center](#) or [ICATT location](#) near you to learn how to access low- or no cost COVID-19 tests provided by the federal government.

The tests available for order:

- Are rapid antigen at-home tests, not PCR.
- Can be taken at home or other locations. Give results within 30 minutes (no lab drop-off required).
- Can be used for testing even if you do not have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Can be used for testing whether you are up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines or not.
- Are also referred to as self-tests or over the counter (OTC) tests.
